

### **Parish Clerk pay frequency request.**

I have experienced many issues getting paid my first two monthly salary. Added to this is the fact that HMRC have reviewed my pay records and it shows I received no pay on month 1 and double in month 2 (it's the only way you can be input my pay data into their system since they do not recognise two monthly pay), so you in effect 'fooling' their system. They have therefore awarded me a tax code of 1T. This one is not even on their website however, what it means is that they will heavily tax me because of the pattern, which looks erratic, until they see a much longer pay history.

What would benefit me and TPC cash flow would be for me to be paid on a monthly basis.

My annual pay is £10,400.00. Monthly gross pay therefore would be £866.66. I can't say what the net would be until I have input the new tax code, but it could be approx. £630.00.00 and HMRC contribution of approx. £375.00 per month.

This would involve 2 more cheques being made out and cashed (one for me, one for HMRC) between meetings 6 times a year. Since cheques are made out between meetings regularly, I would hope this change could be accommodated and not create too much inconvenience to the council.
